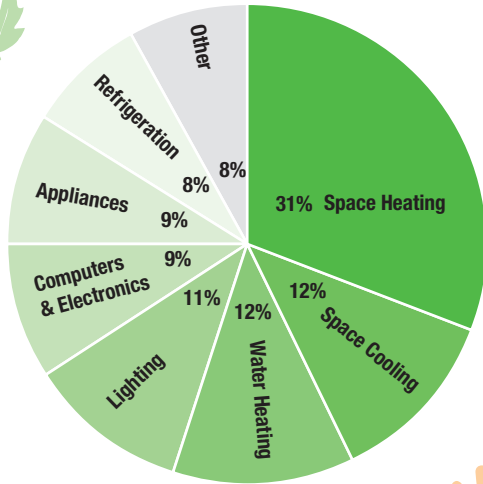


How **Energy-Efficient** Is Your Home?

Appliance Recycling

If you have a second refrigerator, we will pick it up at a time convenient to you, recycle it for free, and pay you \$30.

When we pick-up your refrigerator, we can also collect and recycle old, inefficient window or wall air conditioners. We'll pay you \$35 for window units and \$100 for wall air conditioners.

This program is available to Con Edison residential customers who live in one-to-four family homes. Refrigerators and air conditioners must be in working condition to qualify for recycling. Customers must provide clear and safe access to the appliance for pick-up. Air conditioners should be removed from windows or wall installation locations. Water hoses should be disconnected from refrigerators.

Heating and Cooling Rebates for Homes

Is your central air conditioner or heating system more than 12 years old? You could cut your annual heating and cooling costs 30 percent* by replacing it with high-efficiency technology.

Homeowners can receive **rebates of up to \$1,000** for installing eligible energy-efficient equipment including:

- Central air conditioners
- Furnaces
- Heat pumps
- Ductless mini-split systems
- Programmable thermostats
- Electric water heaters
- Indirect water heaters
- Water and steam boilers
- Duct and air sealing



If you are converting from an oil to natural gas heating system, you may also receive additional incentives when you install high-efficiency gas heating equipment.

Qualifying equipment can be installed by a licensed contractor of your choice who meets all New York State and local municipality requirements.
